The EMOS Certificate

- Label provided European Statistical System (ESS) and the European System of Central Banks, Supported by Eurostat.
- In Germany: Trier, Bamberg, Berlin (Ma Statistics) linked by cooperation in Survey Statistics, Dortmund, LMU München
- In Berlin: Extra Certificate, stating your experience and knowledge in Official Statistics
- Mandatory internships and master thesis in the field of Official Statistics plus 50 ECTS on modules related to Official Statistics (so-called Learning Outcomes)

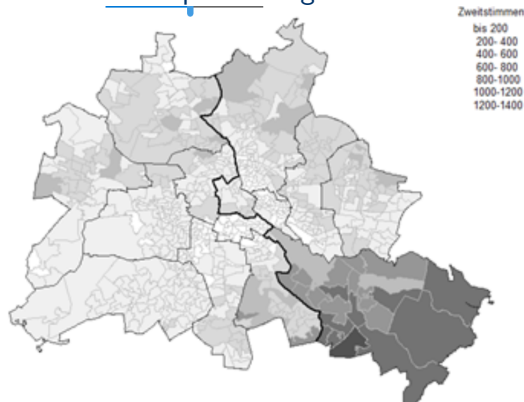
- Training: Official Statistics should be represented in statistical curricula
- Recruiting: already 3 participants have a job at the Amt für Statistik Berlin-Brandenburg
- Capacity building for higher education levels in the ESS

Some examples: Voting maps (Berliner Abgeordneten Haus)

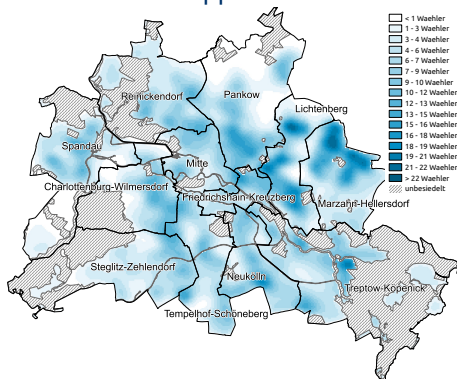
A standard map of voting results: No. of voters in election district

An alternative approach: Number of voters per pixel

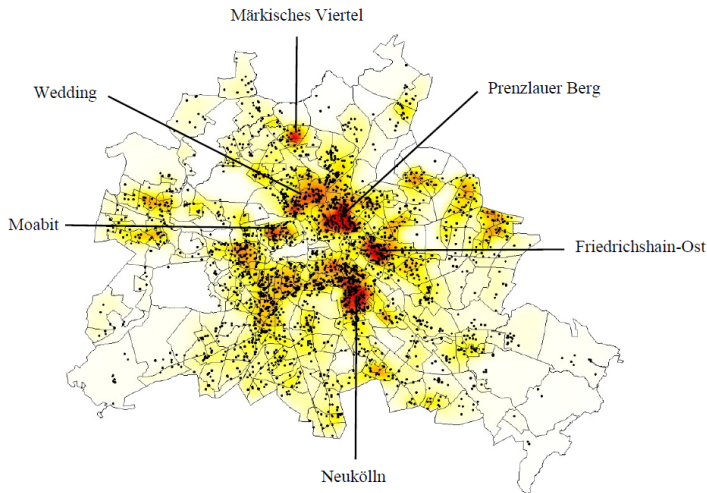


There are AfD hotspots located in East **and** West-Berlin

The distribution of children and the Kindergartens

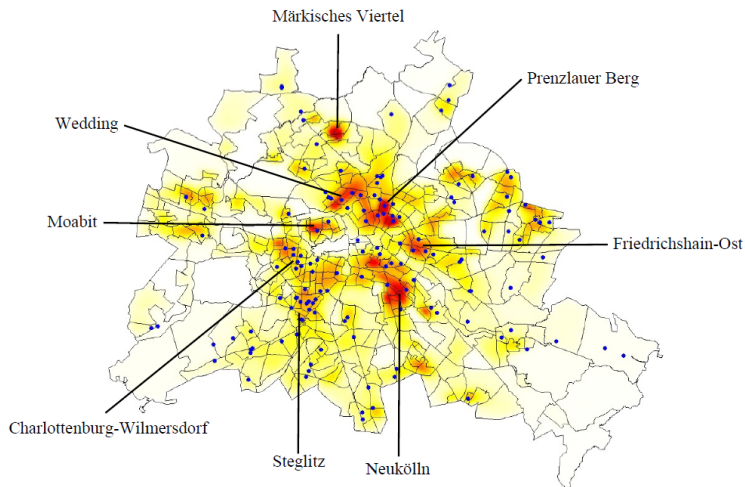
